

## Application Documents for M.Sc. Candidates - Check List

- Candidate application
- Academic achievements (grades and class ranking)
- Not Mandatory: GRE test results: Quantitative reasoning (85% or higher); Analytical writing (3.5 or higher)
- University rank
- B.Sc. Diploma
- Recommendation letter from the future magister supervisor.
- Two official recommendation letters from faculty (other than the future supervisor) that will evaluate the student's achievements (recommendations need to be sent directly to the graduate school by email).
- Candidate letter
- Scholarship Application (if requested by the student).
- Curriculum vitae
- Publications (PDF files)
- Research proposal including topic (up to 2 pages)
- Personal interview – the advisor will conduct a personal interview with the student on Skype/Zoom to assess the student's communication skills in English and the student's academic background.
